The Findlay-based organization, Mission Possible, runs 6 schools in Haiti.

Several people from northwest Ohio are in Haiti. They are part of a medical mission organized through the group "Mission Possible". The Hancock County charity has been doing work in the impoverished nation for more than 30 years.

The Findlay-based organization runs 6 schools in Haiti. They educate and feed thousands of children every day. And the good news is that everyone who is part of their mission team and their schools is alive.

Obviously, communication out of Haiti has been spotty at best. But the team members have been able to send e-mails back and forth since the earthquake. Kurt Bishop is the president of Mission Possible. His wife is part of the team in Haiti. He says the organization's school buildings are all outside Port au Prince.

They did not sustain any damage other than things like shaking walls and collapsing shelves. He says a normal day in the country is chaotic at best and he can't imagine what it's like as the country faces this unbelievable devastation.

The Mission Possible medical team was in Haiti to run a clinic for women and babies outside the capital city, but they are hoping to be able to take their supplies and equipment into Port au Prince to help. "They have knowledge and willingness to go, that is where their hearts are. Whether or not they will get there is the question. We'll have to see how it all happens for them over the next few days," says Trace Roth.


Kurt Bishop says, "Things have a tendency after disasters in Haiti to go downhill quickly; things like riots, blockades at roads, fires and that's a little bit of a concern for us right now."
