School Lunches for Haiti

Stow, Ohio – (January 27, 2010) – Cornerstone Community School has partnered with Mission Possible to collect money for students in Haiti. Director of Advancement, Kim Polatas states "after the devastating earthquake that has rocked Haiti, we felt it imperative to do something. Mission Possible is an organization that we have connections with through two of our families so it was an obvious choice. Kurt Bishop, the Executive Director of Mission

Possible, stated that continuing to get food to students in Haiti was the greatest current need".

Mrs. Polatas introduced the project to students at Monday Morning Meeting on January 25th. She told the students that the cost of feeding a child lunch for one month was \$4.08 and then challenged them to bring in enough money to feed 95 students. The children were immediately receptive to the idea. Mrs. Kropp's kindergarten class brought in \$89 in two days! Additionally, two of our families have offered to match what the students bring in by March 5th.

Cornerstone is committed to provide service learning opportunities to students throughout the year. As the all school unit on Island Life begins this week students will continue to learn about Haiti and how they can help the impoverished country.
